Note: The April 1, 2000 Population Estimates base reflects changes to the Census 2000 population from the Count Question Resolution program and geographic program revisions. Abbreviations: Black = Black or African American

Note: These estimates include modifications to the Census 2000 Summary File (SF-3) data to ensure conformity with OMB required racial categories. The counts in the "Some other race" category in the SF-3 file have been allocated to one of the specific race categories (White, Black, Asian or Other). Adjustments were also made to correct misreporting in the "Two or more races" category (e.g. reporting black and Hispanic as two races).
